We are thrilled to announce the first edition of the Speed Track Series World Cup - World Final, a landmark global competition that will elevate the sport to new heights. This prestigious event per Clubs or Brand Teams will bring together the best Senior skaters from the Continental Stages, and will take place in Xinhua, Hunan Province, People's Republic of China on November 22nd-23rd 2025.

PARTICIPANTS

This event will be only for Senior category Women and Men to participate. There are two (2) participant groups:

- Qualified skaters from the Continental Track Series or Continental Areas (exempt from entry fee)
- Wild Cards skaters: athletes that will follow the Open registration process (required to pay entry fee)

COMPETITION FORMAT

The races for both participant groups will be per race type and gender:

Short Distance: 200m DTT & 500m +D

Long Distance: 5.000m Points race & 10.000m Elimination race

The Wild Card skaters will have the opportunity to join the Qualified Skaters group, by winning their own qualification round at the beginning of each day.



The number of Wild Card skaters that will join the Qualified skaters, will be communicated after the registration closes.

ATHLETES' PRIZE MONEY

We are excited to unveil the prizes that await those who rise to the challenge and showcase unparalleled skill, determination and sportsmanship. They will be honored with prestigious awards recognizing their standout performances and extraordinary skills.

The top 10 Women and top 10 Men in each type of race (Short and Long Distances) will share a total prize pool of **USD 40,000**. The four rankings are:

- * Women Short Distances
- * Women Long Distances
- * Men Short Distances
- * Men Long Distances as shown in the table below:

RANKING

As per Article 17 of the Track Series World Final Rulebook (<u>link</u>), the Final Ranking is built as follows:

17.1. For the Track Series World Final, the rankings are calculated by points.



- 17.2. Separate rankings per gender and race type (short distance and long distance races) will be prepared after each event.
- 17.3. A skater may participate in short and long distance races (there is no Clubs' ranking).
- 17.4. Points will be assigned as follows: 1st place 30 points, 2nd place 29 points, 3rd place 28 points, for 4th to 15th place points will decrease progressively as follows: 26 / 24 / 22 / 20 / 18 / 16 / 14 / 12 / 10 / 8 / 6 / 4. All other ranked skaters 2 points.
- 17.5. If skaters have the same amount of points in the stage ranking, the winner will be one having the better position/ranking in the last distance.
- 17.6. Disqualified skaters for sports or disciplinary faults (DQ-SF / DQ-DF) do not receive any point.

<u>UNIFORM</u>

Skaters must wear their Clubs or Sponsor Team skinsuit, no National team uniforms are allowed.

OFFICIAL TRAINING

There will be official training sessions on Thursday and Friday. The schedule will be informed in the next bulletin.

REGISTRATION



The registration process for all the Athletes (both Pre-Qualified and Wild Card) and Coaches will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity Platform.

World Skate Infinity is available both on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store (Android)</u> and <u>App Store (iOS)</u>.

To be registered for the event, please complete the corresponding Google Form and sign up on the World Skate Infinity Platform by creating your profile (if you haven't done so yet).

Once the steps above have been completed, World Skate will verify the information, confirm who is a Pre-Qualified athlete, and proceed to register both Pre-Qualified and Non-Qualified Senior athletes in Infinity.

This process may take up to 10 days.

Non-Qualified Senior Athletes will then be able to pay the event registration fee of 100 USD directly in Infinity, either by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

The Google Forms will be open from October 10th to November 12th.

<u>ANTIDOPING</u>

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration Platform (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024, 2025 are accepted.



Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

VISA

It is recommended to contact the Chinese Embassy/Consultant in your country or region to verify your travel requisites based on your nationality, and apply for a visa ahead of time if it is the case.
