- (2) Athletes are allowed to register all events.
- (3) Quota: For every age group, each participating team is allowed to register 6 athletes per discipline and 4 athletes in any Relay race.
- (4) Athletes of the same team participating in Relay are allowed to register in an older category.

16. VISA

For some countries/regions it takes longer working days to apply for an entry visa, it is advised that you check the requirements with the Taiwan consulate/embassy of your country in advance.

17. Travel Cost

- (1) Each national/regional team is entitled to four free hospitality quotas. The cost of accommodation, meals and transport expenses during 14th to 17th, November 2024 in Taiwan will be paid by CTRSF. The other team members shall be responsible for their own cost.
- (2) The Organizers will provide and is responsible for accommodation and local transportation for accredited international judges and officials from World Skate. However, The Organizers shall not be responsible for their overseas transportation service.

18. Insurance

- (1) During the competition period, the Organizer shall procure Public Liability Insurance. The coverage and terms shall be subject to the provisions stipulated in the insurance policy. The insured items and coverage limits are as follows:
 - 1. Bodily injury liability per person: NT\$3,000,000
 - 2. Bodily injury liability per accident: NT\$15,000,000
 - 3. Property damage liability per accident: NT\$2,000,000
 - 4. Maximum aggregate liability under this insurance contract: NT\$34,000,000
- (2) In the event that a participant sustains bodily injury or property loss due to participation in the competition, the Organizer will assist in handling the claims process under the Public Liability Insurance. However, the eligibility for compensation, scope of coverage, and amount payable shall be determined in accordance with the terms of the insurance policy and the assessment of the insurance company. Should the claim be deemed ineligible (including, but not

limited to, items already compensated, exclusions specified in the policy, or incidents not covered under the insurance), the participant shall not seek any form of compensation or indemnity from the Supervising Authority, the Organizer, the Co-organizer, or any Sponsor.

19. Notice

- (1) The Organizers shall reserve the right to use any photograph/video taken at this event and may use the aforementioned photographs/videos in publications or other media materials for advertising or promotional purposes.
- (2) Participating teams must have the appropriate insurance to cover medical illnesses, injuries and emergency medical treatment.
- (3) By completing the registration process, each participant shall be deemed to have thoroughly read, understood, and fully agreed to comply with all rules, regulations, and provisions set forth for this event.
